Dear Inbounds of the Rotary District 1890 and 1880

Dear Parents,

Dear Inbounds,

One of the highlights, some call it the main highlight, of your exchange year is according to many of the outbounds the Europe travel tour.

That is why we're sending you this message already now, if it is possible in your mother language (translated to English, Spanish, Chinese and Portuguese), because you have to talk, plan, and discuss about your participation and sign in before your exchange year begins.

We will travel with a group of around 50 inbounds overall and normally every Inbound of our District participates. Because you or more precisely your parents have to take charge of the costs of the travel, is the participation of course voluntary.

During this unique experience to travel three weeks all through Europe with your friends, you will visit many cities in Europe and get to know something about the different cultures in Europe. Take a look at the current plans for this year's trip on our homepage at www.rotary-Europareise-1890.de.

It is planned that the travel begins in May/June of 2020 in Hamburg. Most likely, we'll be visiting Venice, Rome, Pisa, Monaco, Barcelona, London, and Amsterdam, though the exact plan hasn't been determined as of yet and can still change.

We will stay overnight in Hostels or low price Hotels. We will try to get breakfast and dinner wherever it is possible as well as packed lunches for the trips. On some of the days, you also have to buy food and drinks for yourself. Our coach is very new and technically at the best. Services like for example the fairy trip to Venice, access to the Vatican museum, metro tickets, city guides or fees for the Euro Tunnel or something common are included in the price for the whole trip.

For that I recommend a pocket money of 15-20 € per day, that means 300-350 € for the whole trip, which is not included in the overall cost of the trip.

Adult Rotaries and Rotexers, who volunteer to make that trip possible for you, will accompany the trip.

IMPORTANT for PARENTS: Sometimes it can be very expensive and difficult to transfer the payments for the trip from outside of Germany. Because of this, we recommend that parents give the

The cancellation of an inbound's participation on the trip will be checked by us before we inform you later.

Number of participants District 1890 guarantees the possibility of a participation for every Inbound of the district, if the binding registration is completed until the 31.08.2019 as well as the deposit has been made until the 15.09.2019

After that, the district is free to offer the remaining spots to Inbounds of the other districts with the same conditions.

Visa regulations: With a valid visa or residency permit for Germany, it's possible for inbounds to travel within most European countries. For this trip, all the countries that we visit are member states of the European Union, and because of that, no separate visa other than the visa or residency permit necessary for the inbound's stay in Germany will be necessary.

However, there are some exceptions with our visit to the United Kingdom. Most countries in Africa, as well as Colombia, Ecuador, and Peru, will need an additional visa for this part of the trip. Those inbounds who come from the countries in question should think about applying for and receiving this visa in their home countries before coming to Germany, since the process will be more complicated after arriving in the host country.

Without question, under current standards, all inbounds from South America (except for those from Colombia, Ecuador, and Peru), Mexico, USA, Canada, New Zealand, Australia, Taiwan, Japan, and Thailand can visit the UK without an additional visa.

We will keep you updated through our homepage, www.europareise-1890.de, as well as at the inbound orientations organized by Rotary District 1890 throughout the course of the exchange.

Rotary District 1890, as well as the organizers and leaders of the trip reserve the right to make changes to the planning of the trip, price, destinations, and dates.

We're glad to offer each inbound an exciting, memorable, and interesting Eurotour in 2020.

Because of that, we ask you not to send question about the travel by now. You will receive enough information later and you will have the opportunity to ask questions.
